



## Heavy-Duty Diesel Idling Implementation

### Need to Ensure Implementation is Occurring

- Ensure clarity in how complaints are received and processed
- Need to clarify roles & responsibilities
- Track any enforcement actions
- Track public outreach efforts

### Identified Potential Idling Locations

- Bastrop County
  - Bastrop Exxon at 1273 Highway 71 West, Bastrop
  - Bastrop Travel Svc at 1350 Highway 71 West, Bastrop
  - Picnic areas along US-290
- Caldwell County
  - Love's at I-10 exit 632 in Luling
  - Exxon Mustang Travel Center at 13701 US 183 S, Buda
- Hays County
  - Texas Best Conoco at 18701 Interstate 35, Kyle
  - Dorsett Two Twenty One Truck Stop at 15201 S Interstate 35, Buda
  - San Marcos Truck Stop at 209 N Interstate 35, San Marcos
  - Rest Area at I-35 NB exit 212
- Travis County
  - Speedy Stop off I-35 exit 248 in Pflugerville
  - Warehouse area at Promontory Point, at Intersection of 290 and 183
  - Other warehouse areas
- Williamson County
  - Doc's One Stop Shop at 12800 N Interstate 35, Jarrell
  - Exxon at 12820 N Interstate 35, Jarrell
  - Flying J at 11710 N Interstate 35, Jarrell
  - Texas Star Station at 9111 N Interstate 35, Jarrell
  - Sunmart/Berry Creek Truck Stop at 3800 N Interstate 35, Georgetown
  - Rest areas at exits 255 and 256 on I-35

### TCEQ Proposed Rule Change

- Changes enforcement period from April 1-October 31 to be year-round
- Institutes exemption for armored cars
- Reinstates exemption for idling during government-mandated rest period if not within two miles of facility offering external heating or conditioning
- Removes prohibition of idling in residential areas, school zones, and near hospitals
- Each MOA will have to be updated to add armored car exemptions and enforce year-round
- Proposal: January 26; Comment Period: February 11-March 11; Hearing March 1, Adoption: June 22
