## **Frequently Asked Criminal Justice Advisory Committee (CJAC) Application Review and Prioritization Questions**

### **PROBLEM STATEMENT**

- Can you give more detail on why this project is needed?
- Have you presented this project for city/county support?

### **SUPPORTING DATA**

- Why is outdated information used for the supporting data?
- Do you have current statistics to support the problem statement?

### **GOAL STATEMENT**

- Can you provide more detail about how your project will impact the stated problem?

### **COMMUNITY PLANNING**

- Did you and/or your agency participate in the FY 2011 community planning process?

### **ACTIVITIES**

- Are there other agencies in your area providing same or like services?
- How long has your agency been providing these types of services?

### **OUTPUT/OUTCOME MEASURES**

- How many clients do you currently serve?
- Will this project expand or enhance current service levels?
- How long will it take you to get this project up and running?

### **BUDGET**

- What is your agencies annual operating budget for the current?
- What percent of each dollar goes toward direct services?
- How did you come up with the budget/cost for your project?
- How are you planning to sustain this project when funding runs out?
- What other funding do you have in place to support this project?
- What other types of funding does your agency receive?
- If you were to receive the requested funding, what percent of your total agency budget would it represent?
