# Criminal Justice Grants Program

Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division Grants Application Process

Timeline will be updated as meeting and workshop dates are finalized

- August 31, 2018 – Send PY 2020 CAPCOG Regional Criminal Justice Needs Survey out to stakeholders
- September 17, 2018 – Response period ends for FY 2018 CAPCOG Regional Criminal Justice Regional Needs Survey
- September 25, 2018 - CJAC Meeting to kick off new grant year, and update Policy Statement
- October 1, 2018 Afternoon – Stakeholder Planning Meeting #1 – CAPCOG Pecan Room
- October 3, 2018 Morning – Stakeholder Planning Meeting #2 – CAPCOG Pecan Room
- November 2, 2018 - CJAC Meeting to update priorities and give input on the strategic plan
- December 13, 2017 – CAPCOG Executive Committee approves new regional plan and priorities
- December 14, 2018 – PY 2020 RFAs released by Office of the Governor for Plan Year 2020
- **January, 8, 9, 10, & 15, 2019 –4 mandatory grantee workshops. Grant applicants in the region must attend one to be eligible.**
- **February 28, 2019 – Criminal justice grant applications due to CJD via eGrants**
- Mid-March 2019 – 14 days after application period closes CJD forwards: General Victim Assistance – Direct Services; Violence Against Women Criminal Justice and Training Program; Juvenile Justice Grant Program; and Justice Assistance Grant Program applications to COGs
- March 28, 2019 – CJAC Meeting to go over scoring process and discuss applications prior to application review meetings
- **April, 9-11, 2019 – Three-days of CJAC application review meetings at CAPCOG (3<sup>rd</sup> day of meetings will be dependent on the number of applications)**
- May 8, 2019 – Final Priority List presented to CAPCOG Executive Committee for Approval
- May 9, 2019 – Regional project prioritization list from CAPCOG due to CJD
- August 31, 2019 – FY2019 performance period ends
