CAPCOG will submit scoring, ranking, and funding recommendations to the OOG. final Prioritization list will be distrubted to all applicants. 12.

OOG APPLICATION REVIEW:

After the COG's priority listing, the PSO will verify the eligibility, reasonableness and cost effectiveness strategy of the proposed project, and the availability of funding, and will render final funding decisions on grant applications.

CJAC FUNDING RECOMMENDATION:

The CJAC will determine the method to use when recommending funding for each Application. The CJAC will determine the recommended funding recommendation for all application.
